Senator EGGLESTON asked:

- 1. What is the cost of establishing the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority under the National Health and Hospitals Network reform?
- 2. How many staff will the Authority employ?

Answer:

- 1. The 2010 Federal Budget provided \$91.8 million over four years to establish the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority (IHPA) and to support the operations of the Authority during the forward estimates period.
- 2. The Department of Health and Ageing have advised that, as proposed, the Chief Executive Officer of the IHPA would have responsibility for making financial and staffing decisions.
