Senator BUSHBY: That is fine. What was the cost of the summer school and were any profits made by ASIC?

Answer:

The ASIC Summer School is budgeted on a cost recovery basis. In 2011 the ASIC Summer School held in Sydney from 21 to 23 February generated revenue of \$715,232. No profit was made by ASIC after externally provided goods and services and ASIC staff costs to plan and manage the event were taken into account.
