- 1. What has been the total expenditure to date from the National Workforce Development Fund?
- 2. What are the top 10 courses funded?
- 3. What is the average cost of these courses?

ANSWER

- 1. As at 12 June 2012, \$158 million (GST exclusive) in Government funding has been committed through the National Workforce Development Fund (NWDF). This includes \$49 million in funding committed through the Critical Skills Investment Fund (CSIF) which is now incorporated under the NWDF.
- 2. and 3. The NWDF is in early stages of implementation. Details of the training undertaken will be collected on a quarterly basis. The top 10 courses and the average cost per learner under CSIF Funding Agreements are as follows:
