Senator MASON: Probably not. Is it possible for this committee to obtain a copy of the TEQSA report of your investigation into the UQ enrolment?

Dr Nicoll: There is not a report per se. There were papers that would have come to the commission in terms of analysis. I would have to take on notice what we would be in a position to provide the committee.

Senator MASON: So there is no report per se. Clearly there was a recommendation made.

Dr Nicoll: There were commission papers. Papers come to the commission for decision. Documentation and analysis would have come to the commission. I would need to take on notice what part of that we might be in a position to provide the committee.

Senator MASON: I am sure that the committee would appreciate anything that you can provide. I can understand the sensitivities with this. I am not blind to them. But if it is possible I would appreciate that.

Senator Chris Evans: It is best that Dr Nicoll takes it on notice and take some advice. As you know, it is highly controversial.
