- 32. How many Ministerial staff does the department provide?
- 33. To what Minister or Parliamentary Secretary are they assigned?
- 34. What is the total cost of these staff?
- 35. Can the Department provide data on how many staff are in each salary band?

ANSWER

All Agencies

The Department of Industry, Tourism and Resources provides 4 Departmental Liaison Officers (DLOs) for the portfolio Ministers and Parliamentary Secretary.

- 2 DLOs are assigned to the Minister for Industry, Tourism and Resources (the Hon Ian Macfarlane MP) these are Executive Level 2 officers.
- 1 DLO is assigned to the Minister for Small Business and Tourism (the Hon Fran Bailey MP) this is an Executive Level 1 officer.
- 1 DLO is assigned to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Tourism and Resources (the Hon Warren Entsch MP) this is an Executive Level 1 officer.

The total cost for the Departmental Liaison Officers is approximately \$457,000 pa. This comprises salaries (approx. \$339,650 pa), parliamentary allowances (approx. \$52,800 pa) and employee related costs in relation to superannuation and leave entitlements (approx. \$64,550 pa).
