## Senator O'Brien asked about:

If you are collecting statistics, can you give us some details of the highest and the lowest number of contacts?

#### **ANSWER**

For the 6 months from 1 January to 30 June 2006, the average lowest number of contacts per month was 111 and the highest number was 10,793.

The variation is influenced by a range of factors including:

- the business demographics of the different regions including the number of small businesses, the size of the region and the distribution of small businesses across the region.
- the number of field officers, full time and part time, servicing any region.
