- 1. Has a group called the National Reference Group been established in relation to the new legislation? If so:
  - a. On what dates has this Group met?
  - b. On what dates have the minutes for each of those meetings been circulated to the attendees and are you able to make those minutes available to us as well?
  - c. That group is presumably separate to the new advisory committee that was announced on 13 October 2011?
  - d. Why do both of these new groups include R&D tax consultants, given the Minister has previously described these people as "vested interests", "well-organised" campaigners and "losers (who) scream like ... stuck pigs"?
- 2. Will any details be made available publicly under the new scheme about the payments that have been made to businesses and, if so, how?

## **ANSWER**

- 1. Yes.
  - a. The R&D Tax National Reference Group (NRG) met on 12 August 2011.
  - b. Provisional minutes were circulated to members on 17 October 2011 with a view to formal acceptance at the next meeting.
  - c. Yes. The NRG is a separate body to the R&D Tax Incentive Advisory Committee.
  - d. R&D tax consultants are key stakeholders and their participation is an important component of the effective administration of the R&D Tax Incentive.
