Can you provide a list of research projects currently being developed in the field of radioisotope production?

ANSWER

Currently there are three direct projects:

- 1. The development and validation of a technique for expanded Lutetium-177 production. Lutetium-177 is used in the treatment of neuro-endocrine disease.
- 2. The validation and eventual commercial licensing of a Gallium-68 generator. Gallium-68 is used in diagnosis of neuro-endocrine disease and other ailments.
- 3. The reduction of impurity levels in Gallium-68.
