**Senator Bushby asked:** 

For the year 2010-11, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

## **Answer:**

At 30 June 2011, the ATO (including the Australian Valuation Office, Tax Practitioners Board and Australian Business Register) had 478 employees (non-ongoing) engaged on specific term contracts. The average length of the contracts was 449 days or approximately 14.75 months.
