Senator Bob Brown asked:

312. Can you provide annual estimates of the amount provided for each state under horizontal fiscal equalisation or similar principles since the Commission was established in 1933?

Answer:

The Commonwealth Budget papers for each year report all payments made by the Commonwealth to the States and Territories. This includes the source of funding used for HFE and the amount provided to each State and Territory.

The funding provided to each state under horizontal fiscal equalisation (HFE) is currently distributed from the pool of Good and Services Tax (GST) revenue.

The pool of funding distributed by HFE has changed several times since the Commonwealth Grants Commission was established in 1933. Table 1 shows the source of the funding used for HFE from 1959-60 to the present.
