# Senator Bushby asked:

How many FOI requests has the Department received for the year 2010-11?

(a) How many have been granted or denied?

#### Answer:

In 2010-11, the ATO received 852, freedom of information requests (and retained on hand 67 cases from 2009-10).

- (a) Decisions were made in 582 cases:
  - I. the ATO granted full access in 148 requests
  - II. the ATO allowed part access in 320 requests
  - III. the ATO denied access in 114 cases.

158 requests were withdrawn by applicants before a decision was made.

There were 179 cases on hand at the end of the year.
