## Answer:

725. The Office of the Australian Information Commission has issued guidelines under s 93A of the Freedom of Information Act 1982. On 24 June 2011, the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet provided FOI Guidance Notes to all departments http://www.dpmc.gov.au/foi/guidance_notes.cfm.
726. Treasury received 159 requests in the year 2010-11. Fourteen requests were on hand as of 1 July 2010.

726a. The following action was taken on requests in 2010-11:
12 granted access in full
56 granted access in part
29 access refused or no documents located
4 transferred in whole
43 withdrawn (either by applicant or time lapsed)
29 current as at 30 June 2011
727. Nil, conclusive certificates were abolished on 7 Oct 2009.
728. Treasury received 61 requests for this FYTD (from 1 July 2011 to 20 October 2011).

728a. Of the 61 requests received, there were:
7 granted access in part
4 refused (as one or more exemptions in the Freedom of Information Act 1982 applied)

19 withdrawn (either by applicant or time lapsed)
7 no documents exist
1 transferred to another Agency
23 pending
729. Nil, conclusive certificates were abolished on 7 Oct 2009.
