Answer:

771. During the 2010-11 financial year the Treasury's total expenditure on education was \$4.9 million. There were 7,772 participants with an average cost per participant of \$630. The costs are broken down as follows:

Studies Assistance: \$0.367m Occupational Health and Safety: \$0.003m Courses / Seminars: \$4.530m

\$1.2 million has been spent on education as at 30 September 2011. There were 1,632 participants with an average cost per participant of \$735. The costs are broken down as follows:

Studies Assistance: \$0.090m Occupational Health and Safety: \$0.001m Courses / Seminars: \$1.109m
