### Answer:

### Growth Places

As a part of the Higher Education Review, the Department calculated that 1360 places would be required from 2007 to keep pace with anticipated population change.

Whilst 1400 growth places were originally intended to be introduced into the sector in 2007 to account for this, amendments to the reform package saw this number double to 2800 places (pipelining to 6700 in 2008).
