#### **Question:**

On p.14 of the Establishment Grants evaluation report it says that 86 new schools received Establishment Grants for 2001 and 2002.

With answer E740\_03, the Department provides a listing of schools approved in each year 1999-2002. This lists only 53 schools receiving grants as new schools for 2001 and 2002.

Can you please reconcile these figures?

Please provide a complete listing of all schools, with year and enrolments as provided with E740\_03, receiving Establishment Grants for all years 1999-2003. Please indicate, for 2001 and 2002, which schools were not listed in the attachment to E740\_03.

Please also provide, with details, a listing of schools which have added extensions to another level of education, since 1999 inclusive.

#### **Answer:**

*Establishment Grants: 2001 and 2002*

The table provided with answer E740\_03 contained a list of 89 new schools approved for Australian Government General Recurrent Grant (GRG) funding and eligible for Establishment Grant payments. The list shows 54 schools were approved between 2001 and 2002. 35 were approved after commencing between 11 May 1999 and 31 December 2000.

Three schools were omitted from the evaluation report for the following reasons:

<b>School name and year commenced:</b>	<b>Reason for omission:</b>
2000 Clearwater School	The school closed at the end of 2000.
2002 Toogoolawa School	State Registration delayed approval until 2003.
2002 St Stephens Lutheran College	Listed twice as this Systemic school was originally approved as a non-systemic school in 2000. The Lutheran System received the second round of Establishment Grant payments.

Taking the three omissions into consideration, there were 52 schools approved during 2001 and 2002 and 34 schools approved between 11 May 1999 and 31 December 2000. A total of **86** schools received Establishment Grant funding in 2001 and 2002.

An updated list of new schools approved for GRG funding and eligible for Establishment Grant payments for the 1999-2003 programme years is at Attachment A.

A list of schools that have extended to new levels of education (1999 to 2003) is at Attachment B.
