The Department of Family and Community Services has provided the following response in respect of recipients of the Youth Allowance, Austudy Payment and the Pensioner Education Scheme under Social Security Law.

The cost of closing the scheme is \$204.4 million over 4 years and includes the DEST expense. This does not include possible payment of doubtful debts (DFaCS PBS page 210).
