- (a) the number of employers in each State
- (b) the average number of employees employed by the employer
- (c) the average number of employees per employer who made a GEERS claim
- (d) the total amount of annual leave payments paid
- (e) the total amount of long service leave paid
- (f) the total amount of notice payments paid
- (g) the total amount of unpaid wages paid
- (h) the total amount of unpaid redundancy pay owed to employees
- (i) the total amount of redundancy pay paid under GEERS
- (j) the total amount of unpaid superannuation
- (k) the average period of time between the time the claim was made and the time the GEERS payments were made.
