#### **Ouestion:**

The Acting Chair asked at *Hansard* page 31:

Has the ILO complained in any way to Australia in the last two years that we are contravening any of the conventions to which we are a signatory, either formally or verbally at meetings that have been attended by government representatives?

### **Answer:**

The only ILO complaint in relation to Australia's compliance to an ILO Convention is in relation to Convention 29, *Forced Labour*, 1930.
