Senator Wong asked in writing:

Please provide a breakdown, according to the above characteristics, (refer W234-05) of the following outcomes for Work for the Dole through 2004:

- the % of job seekers who were in full time unsubsidised employment three months after leaving Work for the Dole
- the same for part time employment.

#### **Answer:**

Individual job seekers are routinely surveyed three months after completion of their Work for the Dole placement through Post Programme Monitoring (PPM). The survey results are then collated.
