### **Question:**

Senator Carr asked in writing:

What advice have you received about why the decision was taken to relocate Indigenous Business Australia (IBA) and the ATSIC Business Development Program (BDP) in DEWR as opposed to, for example, the Department of Industry? What is the rationale for that?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. No advice was provided to IBA.
