Please provide the current figures on the take up rates of Austudy.

#### Answer:

Take up rates for Austudy

Austudy is available to eligible students aged 25 to 64. For 2005, the proportion of full-time students who were on Austudy was 15.1 per cent. This is based on the number of recipients in June and the annual average number of 25 to 64 year olds in full-time education in 2005.

## Austudy: 2005

Austudy (full-time students)*	31,611
Total full-time students aged 16 to 24**	209,800
Take-up rate – Austudy	15.1%
