Question:

In your answer to question E706_06 CSIRO said that any shortfall in external revenue would be offset by external in-kind contributions to the Flagships. What is the distinction between external revenue and external in-kind contributions in this regard?

Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Flagship Revenue

External revenue is revenue that is reflected in CSIRO's accounts. In-kind contributions are direct contributions to the achievement of the Flagship's goals whose cost is borne by Flagship partners and are therefore not reflected in CSIRO's accounts.
