Senator Wong asked in writing:

Page 5 of the AWA Handbook refers to broad salary bands which have been provided as a guide for the negotiation of an appropriate salary rate. The handbook states 'An AWA allows negotiation of a higher pay level when it is considered appropriate to recognise particular skills, experience and performance of an existing employee or where a higher level of pay is needed to attract and retain quality employees with particular skills'.
