Question:

School Chaplaincy

- 1. How many applications for chaplains under the new programme are from schools which already have chaplaincy services?
- 2. Have you had any applications from Exclusive Brethren Schools? Please provide details of which schools and campuses and how the Chaplain will be.
- 3. Can you please provide details of the number of meetings between representatives of the Exclusive Brethren, the people present at those meetings, and a record of correspondence between the Exclusive Brethren and DEST.
- 4. If a school community wanted a Scientologist chaplain could they have one under the new programme?

Answer:

School Chaplaincy

- 1. A full breakdown of applications by new or existing chaplaincy service will be available after applications from the first round have been analysed.
- 2. At the time of providing this information, there have been no applications from Exclusive Brethren Schools for funding under the National School Chaplaincy Programme.
- 3. There have been no meetings or correspondence between the Exclusive Brethren and DEST in relation to school chaplains.
- 4. The school community determines the Chaplaincy service for the school as part of the application. Any Chaplain is required to satisfy the definition of a school chaplain as outlined in section 1.5 of the Guidelines.
