Senator CARR— Is it possible to get a table which tells me where the colleges are, the number of students, what the target numbers were, whether or not the students were enrolled as school based apprentices and the number that are school based apprentices.

Ms Paul— That is fine. I think we have provided some of that, but we can draw it all together.

Senator CARR— And what it has cost for each of those colleges to be established.

Australian Technical Colleges

The attached table identifies for each Australian Technical College open in 2007:

- o the location of campuses open in 2007
- the actual enrolment numbers for 2007 as at the census on 31 March 2007. Further enrolments are anticipated midyear and will be reported at the census on 31 October 2007
- o the target student enrolment numbers for 2007
- the amount allocated to that College in its Funding Agreement with DEST. This is the total amount of the Funding Agreement, providing both capital and operational funding through to the end of 2009.

Colleges are required to place students into Australian School-based Apprenticeships as soon as possible after commencement of their programme so numbers of School-based Apprentices for 2007 will not be established until later this year.
