Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 57 and 58: <u>Personal Support Programme</u>. Further to W927-07 on a financial year basis, can the department please provide details of the data on the proportion of people who returned to the programme one year after exiting?

### **Answer:**

As at March 2007, the proportion of people who returned to the Personal Support Programme one year or more after exiting the programme from 2003-04 to 2005–06 is outlined in the table below.
