#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing:

<u>Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme</u> Have any applications for funding been rejected? If so, how many and on what grounds?

#### **Answer:**

As at 28 February 2007, 19 applicants had been deemed ineligible for assistance.

The most common reasons for refusing a claim are:

- the Australian Industrial Relations Commission certificate is not provided by the applicant, or the certificate indicates the claim did not have merit
- the applicant's income is greater than the UTAS income threshold.

**Estimated cost:** Based on the FOI calculator it has taken approximately 2 hours and 10 minutes at an estimated cost of \$40 to prepare this answer.
