Senator Wong asked in writing:

<u>Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme</u> What is the current income threshold for this scheme? How many applicants have sought special consideration in relation to this scheme? How many applicants have been granted access to the scheme despite their income exceeding the threshold?

Answer:

As at 28 February 2007, the income threshold for the Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme was \$47,745.00.

Nine applicants sought special consideration in relation to the income threshold. Five were granted assistance despite their income exceeding the threshold.
