#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing:

<u>Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme</u> If an application for the scheme must be lodged within 14 days of the issuing for a certificate by the AIRC, how are employees made aware of this requirement? eg does DEWR provide (or require) information sheets for the AIRC to distribute to parties with the certificate?

#### **Answer:**

The Australian Industrial Relations Commission distributes information on the Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme to all potential applicants following the conciliation hearing for their unlawful termination claim. The 14 day lodgement requirement is included in the information provided.
