Question

Primary Schools for the 21st Century

Please list the Primary Schools for the 21st Century projects that remain unfinished in Victoria. When are they expected to be completed? Are there any yet to commence? What are the reasons behind the delay?

Answer

As at 6 March 2012, there were 84 unfinished *Primary Schools for the 21st* Century (P21) projects in Victoria.

Of the 84 P21 projects, 13 were yet to commence construction.

All of the 84 unfinished P21 projects in Victoria have been identified by the relevant education authority as a rephased project.

Consistent with the Government's decision in November 2009 to rephase a portion of P21 funds from 2010-11 to 2011-12, education authorities have had the flexibility to extend the completion dates of individual P21 projects. The reasons for an extension being granted have included:

- Extra time for re-tendering to achieve greater value for money;
- Further consultation required to ensure better program outcomes;
- Environmental factors (such as wet weather); and
- Unforeseen circumstances.
