Question

Senator SIEWERT: I want to follow up a question I asked last time, being question 0773, which is the result of discussion that,

Ms Parker, you and I were having around the percentage of people with a disability who were accessing JSA. It seems to me that under Newstart almost a third of the people that were accessing JSAs were those with some indicator of disability. What I would like to do if possible is ask—if you have them now, yes, but if not take this on notice—whether you have got figures later than that on the breakdown as to those with a disability and those who are not.

Ms Parker: To update the previous ones?

Senator SIEWERT: Yes, to update it. Obviously, I am interested in that because of the change in the eligibility criteria.

Ms Parker: Yes, we will take that on notice.

Senator SIEWERT: I would like the Newstart one now if you have it; if you do not I will ask for it on notice.

Ms Parker: Not an update since then, since 31 August.

Senator SIEWERT: Okay. Basically I want that same breakdown updated for the same period as we have talked about earlier.

Ms Parker: Certainly.
