**Percentage of people undertaking full time training**

Senator NASH: We then moved on to the percentage of those that were undertaking full-time training. Ms Taylor: We had the discussion that we were not able to provide information about full-time and we went through the reasons why. I will take that on notice and see what data we have available for you. Senator NASH: We did, too. Hopefully that has caught you up to the Hansard. Thank you very much.

**Answer**

76 per cent of parents receiving Jobs, Education and Training Child Care Assistance (JETCCFA) use this assistance to undertake study activities. Of the JETCCFA recipients undertaking study activities just over half (54 per cent) undertake full time study.
