Question

Office for Teaching and Learning

1. What are the roles and responsibilities of the Office for Teaching and Learning in the Department of Education?
2. How many FTE positions are allocated to the Office for Teaching and Learning in the Department of Education? Please break these down into actual headcounts, and provide the number of staff on non-ongoing employment arrangements.

Answer

1. The Office for Learning and Teaching (OLT) leads sustainable quality improvement in higher education learning and teaching through a suite of grants, fellowships and awards.
2. As at 26 February 2014, there were 18 FTE positions in the OLT. The headcount is 18 staff. There are no non-ongoing staff employment arrangements.
