Electronic equipment

Answer

The Department of Education provides electronic equipment in line with the DOF Ministerial Entitlements Handbook. Other than phone, iPads and computers, the department has issued data cards, remote access tokens, integrated printer/fax/scanners, televisions, label printers and video conference equipment to the Ministers' and Parliamentary Secretary's premises in Parliament House, Adelaide, Melbourne and Albury.
