#### Question

##### *Schools Funding*

Mr Cook: The minister has written to every state and territory minister outlining what the dollar amount is for their states. We can summarise that and provide that to the committee on notice. Pg82 Senator KIM CARR: I appreciate that. If I can get the funding figures for the forward estimates for each state and territory, that is probably all I need at this time. If there are any other funding schedules that are not covered by that, I would like to know what amounts are involved and for what purpose. Mr Cook: Any other funding schedules? Senator KIM CARR: Yes. Are there any other payments to states for school purposes outside of this agreement? Ms Paul: So, different programs and so on? Senator KIM CARR: Yes, other programs and joint programs. What is the Commonwealth paying to each of the states over the next four years? Ms Paul: We can do that. We will do a consolidation for you.
