Question

Correspondence between the department and Rex Deighton-Smith in relation to RSRT review

Senator CAMERON: Can you provide me with copies of any correspondence between the department and Rex Deighton-Smith in relation to this review and correspondence from Rex Deighton-Smith to the department. Ms Parker: I will take that on notice.

Answer

This request would involve a very significant number of documents as the department is providing the administrative and secretariat support to the Review. Consequently, there is a large amount of correspondence between the department and Rex Deighton-Smith.

Processing this request would divert the resources of this team from its ordinary duties and would be likely to result in the Review being significantly delayed.

Accordingly, the department is of the view that the work involved in processing the request would substantially and unreasonably divert the resources of the department from its other operations.
