Answer:

Learning entitlement

- a) The Learning Entitlement policy was influenced by concerns raised through the process of stakeholder consultation undertaken as part of the Review of higher education, that Commonwealth support for tertiary study be more equitably distributed to the Australian community.
- b) In 2002, 13,575 students commenced studies at the bachelor level, having already attained a bachelor degree.
