Organisational structure

The difference between the organisational structure given by the Maralinga Rehabilitation Advisory Committee (MARTAC) on page 60 of their report and that presented in the report of the project manager (Gutteridge, Haskins and Davy Pty Ltd), is that the role of individual departmental advisers, both scientific and engineering, is shown in the MARTAC organisational plan. The project manager chose to group the Departmental advisers with the Department in their organisational structure.
