## Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Light Metals Flagship

It is also anticipated that external earnings to enhance the growth of Light Metals Flagship will be around \$1m in 2003/4, although the size and proportion of external earnings from the Flagship are expected to grow over time.

The process for defining the projects to be carried out by the Flagship has involved wide consultation with the various partners ranging across the industry and government sectors. The aim of this consultation has been to select the appropriate areas of work, not to gain commitments to funding projects at the initial proof of concept stage. No financial commitments have yet been made towards the Flagship. The R&D work currently under way covers the alumina, aluminium, and titanium sectors.
