Answer:

Budget Paper No. 1 – sources of data

The summary of expenses outlined in Table 7 of the 2003-04 Budget Paper No. 1 relates to the Education Function of the Commonwealth Government. This table has been derived by the Department of Finance and Administration (DoFA) and consists of administered and departmental expenses from a number of portfolios, including DEST. Any further questions regarding the formulation of this table, especially in relation to funding to portfolios other than DEST, should be directed to DoFA.

An analysis of the administered expenses outlined in table 7 for schools, student assistance and school education – specific funding relating to this portfolio, has identified the majority of the elements included are from Outcome Group 1: Individuals achieve high quality foundation skills and learning outcomes from schools and other providers, as well as the inclusion of some elements from Outcome Group 2: Individuals achieve relevant skills and learning outcomes from post school education and training. These elements are outlined in the 2003-04 Budget Paper No. 3 and the 2003-04 Portfolio Budget Statements (PBS), and detailed in the tables below.
