#### **Question:**

Senator Kim Carr asked at *Hansard* page 5:

- (a) What are the number of employees in the retail sector?
- (b) What are the number of AWAs and the growth of AWAs filed in the retail industry

#### **Answer:**

The number of employees in the retail trade in the May Quarter 2003 was 1,315,600 (ABS Cat. No 6203.0).

The number of filed AWAs between July 1 2002 and May 31 2003 in retail was 20,756.

Compared to the period 1 July 2001 to 31 May 2002, in the period 1 July 2002 to 31 May 2003 there has been an increase of 126 per cent in the number of AWAs filed in retail.
