Question:

How much of the \$10.866 million in personal benefits referred to in QoN E343_04 has been paid to New Apprentices doing a Certificate III in Information Technology (Software Applications)?

Answer:

LAFHA Paid to Certificate III Information Technology (Software Applications)

According to Departmental data as at 2 July 2004, there were 3 New Apprentices undertaking a Certificate III in Information Technology (Software Applications) who received Living Away From Home Allowance (LAFHA).

The total amount of LAFHA paid for these 3 New Apprentices was \$7,300.80. None of these was in Victoria.
