For the information provided in E490_04, please provide details of IESIP and IEDA funding broken down by state/territory and school sector. Please provide this information for 2004-05 as well.

Answer:

IESIP and IEDA funding

Indigenous education and training budget allocations for IESIP and IEDA have been apportioned to each of the education sectors in the tables below. For many of the elements the funding component fits neatly into a particular education sector. Where estimates have been made the calculations incorporate the proportion of students in an education sector. As estimates have been used extensively in these tables the apportionment should be viewed as indicative only. Delivery of Indigenous education incorporates a complex set of interrelationships amongst students and institutions eligible for funding.

The estimates in the tables below correlate with totals for administered items in the Portfolio Budget Statements (PBS) for 2004-05. The final Budget estimate for 2003-04 is lower than that originally published in the PBS for 2003-04. The final figures for IESIP and IEDA in the E490_04 table have been adjusted to reflect the new PBS levels in the tables below.

Elements within both IESIP and IEDA programmes will change structurally from the beginning of 2005. The 2004 Census data which will indicate more accurately the 2004-05 education sector break-down will not be available until the end of 2004. Therefore, the estimated 2004-05 break-down for IESIP has the same proportionate dispersion across the States and education sectors as that for 2003-04. Similarly, the estimated 2004-05 break-down for IEDA is also proportionately identical to that for 2003-04.
