Question:

Why is the CRC funding cut by \$51 million in 2005-06? Why are there further cuts in the CRC Programme? Are there any plans to reduce the size of this Programme?

Answer:

CRC funding

Some funds previously allocated for 2005-06 and 2006-07, which have not been committed, have been reallocated to later years to provide a more even funding profile. They have not been cut from the Programme. The amounts are \$51 million in 2005-06 and \$17.6 million in 2006-07.

Backing Australia's Ability – Building our future through science and innovation provides net additional funding of \$65 million for the CRC Programme over the six years 2005-06 to 2010-11.

The allocations for these years are as follows:
