#### Question:

Senator Carr: How many redundancies have occurred in the animal livestock divisions ... in the last two years?

#### Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

#### *Redundancies – CSIRO Livestock Industries*

Since 1 July 2002, twenty-two (22) redundancies have occurred in CSIRO Livestock Industries.

These have occurred at the following sites

Geelong (Australian Animal Health Laboratory)	6
Armidale (FD McMaster Laboratories)	1
Indooroopilly/St Lucia	8*
Prospect (Sydney)	7#

\*Move from Indooroopilly to St Lucia resulting in redundancy for a range of General Services & Infrastructure staff where services were not required at St Lucia (site owned by University of Queensland).

# Closure of Prospect Sydney Laboratory where staff elected not to take up offer of relocation.
