The tables below provide an overview of Australian Government committed funds to the Murdi Paaki trial, including the Department of Education, Science and Training's (DEST's) commitments over the 2003-2006 period.

Australian Government Contribution	\$343,630	\$1,633,000	\$3,121,032	\$5,097,622

Of the Australian Government commitment of \$5,097,622 million, DEST has committed \$1,819,429 million on initiatives in the Murdi Paaki trial. An overview of DEST's committed funds across the 2003-2006 financial years is provided below.

In addition, through its lead agency role, DEST also supports the Murdi Paaki trial through a team of four officers located in Dubbo, New South Wales, who work directly with the Indigenous communities of the region.

The trial also receives support from DEST's National Office through the engagement of DEST's senior executive, and the support of two officers from the Indigenous Education Policy Branch.
