Question:

SOUTHERN SURVEYOR: SAFETY

- (a) Tell me about the episode in Brisbane last December and January. Can you confirm that a marine surveyor refused to allow the Southern Surveyor to undertake anything more than sea trials until remedial work was done on the sewerage tanks?
- (b) What work was done?
- (c) At what cost?

Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Southern Surveyor - Safety

- (a) There was no 'episode' is Brisbane last December/January. A marine surveyor did not refuse to allow the vessel to go to sea for anything other than a sea trial. Scheduled, routine maintenance was undertaken on the vessel's sewerage holding tanks in December. This maintenance was not complete when two days of scheduled sea- trials to test the newly installed sub-bottom profiler and auto-pilot were due. The holding-tank maintenance was completed in January following the vessel's return to Brisbane.

- (c) The approximate cost of the maintenance undertaken was \$77,000.
