## Question:

**Senator Carr**: What has been the turnover of CSIRO Executive Members, including divisional chiefs, over the past four years?

## Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Turnover of CSIRO Executive Members, including divisional chiefs, over the past four years as at 1 June 2005:

The composition of the executive group (defined as the Executive Team, Chiefs of Divisions and Flagship Directors, currently totalling 36), and the number of divisions, has changed over the past four years.

Since 2001 fourteen members of this group have left CSIRO including by way of retirement, resignation, or completion of term.

As at 1 June 2005, of the 21 Chiefs in 2001, five remain as divisional Chiefs (with two of these close to ceasing in the role), six have moved to other positions in the executive group: two as Directors of Flagship programs and four as Group Executives and two have returned to senior research positions (including one as a Federation Fellow).
