DIMIA chairs an Interdepartmental Committee (IDC) on migration with skills needs forming part of the agenda. DEST is a member of the IDC as well as other Commonwealth departments.

DEST chairs an Inter-departmental Committee (IDC) on Skills Needs. DIMIA is a member of the IDC as well as other Commonwealth departments.

Other forums which involve DEST, DIMIA and other agencies include:

- Council of Australian Governments which has established a Commonwealth State
