Question:

Please provide data on offers and acceptances for full-fee paying domestic undergraduate places at university by state and territory for each year between 1998 and 2005. Please provide a breakdown by course. If 2005 data is not yet available, please provide data for 1998 to 2004 and preliminary data for 2005.

Answer:

Offers and Acceptances for Undergraduate Places

- The application process for undergraduate places is in the main managed by state
 Tertiary Admission Centres (TACs). The State TACs provide DEST and the AVCC with
 broad aggregate level data on applications, offers and acceptances. Offers and
 acceptances for full-fee paying domestic undergraduate places are not separately
 identified in this data.
- DEST does collect data on enrolments as part of the Higher Education Student Collection. This data includes information on whether the student was a full-fee paying undergraduate domestic student and is provided below for the years 1996 to 2004. Note that the information is presented as EFTSU (equivalent full-time student units) not actual student numbers. Enrolment data for 2005 will be available in mid 2006.
